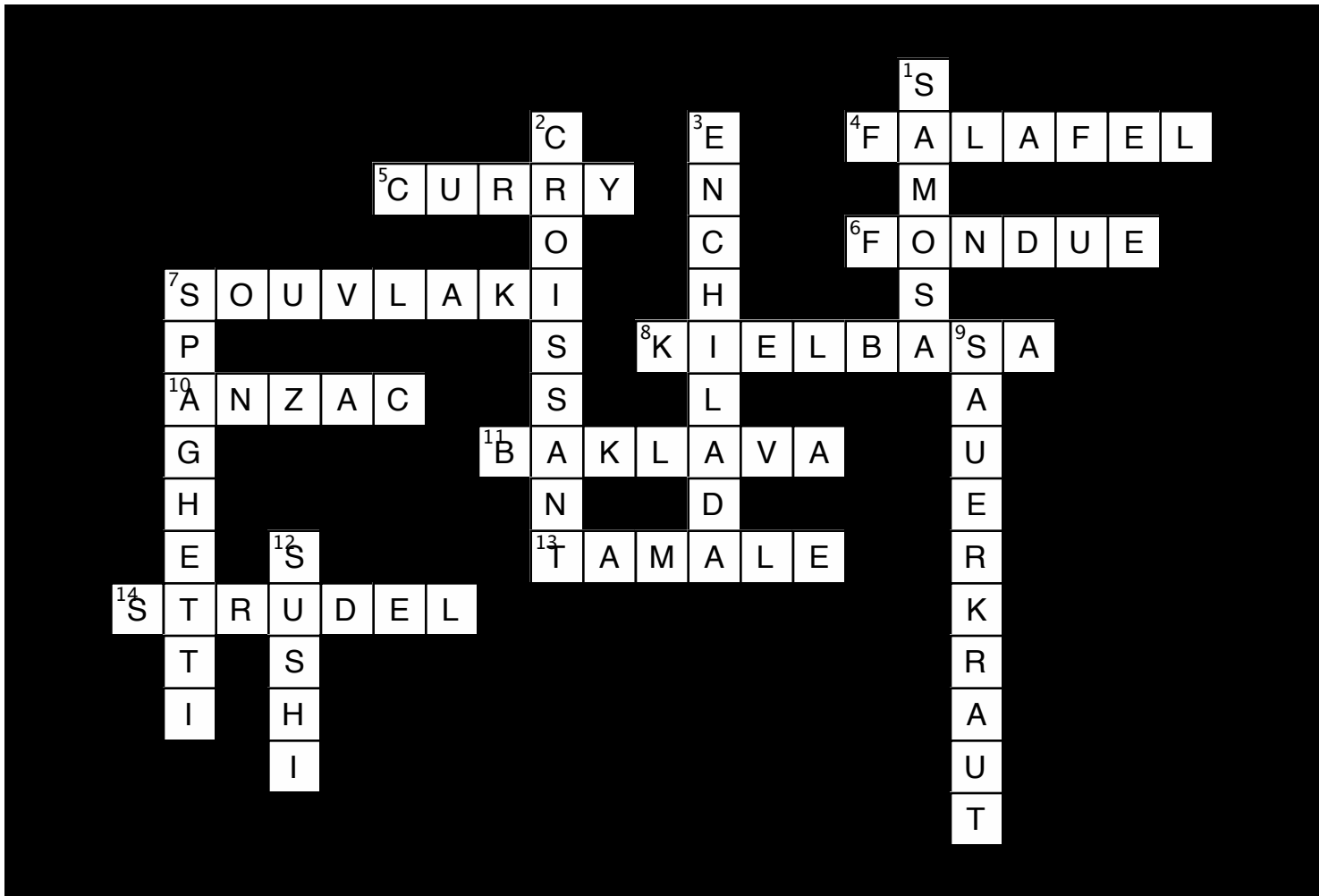


# Untitled Puzzle

## Across

4. A Middle Eastern appetizer or snack consisting of a small croquette of fava-bean flour or ground chick peas, seasoned with toasted sesame seeds and salt [Falafel]
5. A pungent East Indian dish of vegetables, onions, meat or fish, etc., and often eaten with rice [Curry]
6. A dish of Swiss origin made with melted cheese and seasonings together with dry white wine, served as a hot dip for pieces of bread. [Fondue]
7. A Greek dish similar to shish kebab made with lamb [Souvlaki]
8. A Polish smoked sausage of coarsely chopped beef and pork, flavoured with garlic and spices [Kielbasa]
10. Egg-free biscuits baked to mark a public holiday in New Zealand on April 25th [Anzac]

## Down

1. A small fried Indian turnover that is filled with seasoned vegetables or meat. [Samosa]
2. A French crescent-shaped roll of leavened dough [Croissant]
3. A tortilla rolled and filled with a seasoned mixture, usually containing meat, and covered with a sauce flavoured with chilli [Enchilada]
9. German cabbage cut fine, salted, and allowed to ferment until sour [Sauerkraut]
12. A Japanese dish consisting of cooked rice flavoured with vinegar and a variety of vegetable, egg, or raw seafood garnishes [Sushi]

## **Across**

11. A Near Eastern pastry made of many layers of paper-thin dough with a filling of ground nuts, baked and then drenched in honey [Baklava]

13. A Mexican dish made of minced and seasoned meat packed in cornmeal dough, wrapped in corn husks, and steamed [Tamale]

14. An Austrian pastry, usually consisting of a fruit, cheese, or other mixture, rolled in a paper-thin sheet of dough and baked [Strudel]
